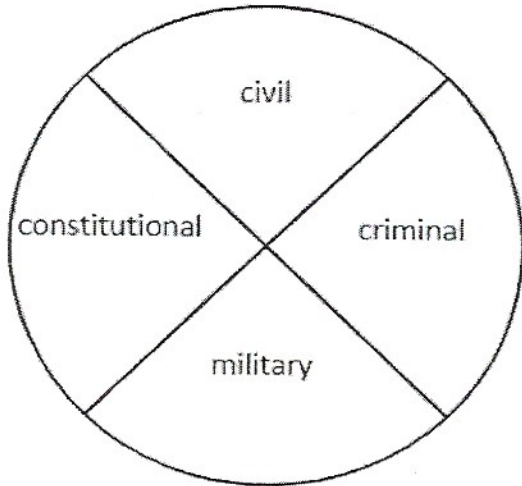


Sources & Types of Laws
