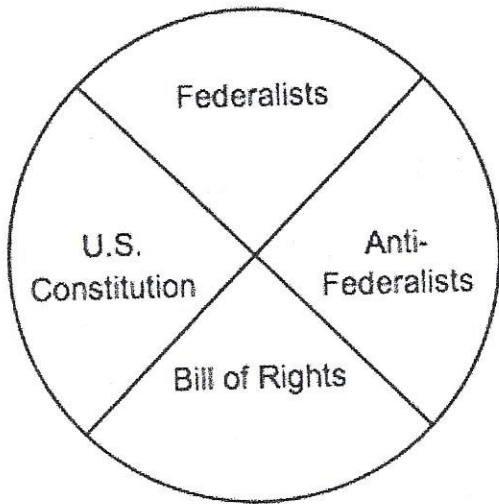


Federalists v. Anti-Federalists
