<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● how a bill becomes a law ● appointment confirmation - Senate approves/denies President's nominations ● standing committee - permanent committee ● special committee - brought together for a specific ● committee selection ● conference committee - temporary, House & Senate, create final version of a bill together ● impeach - remove official from office; House brings charges, Senate holds trial 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● executive order - order from President, treated like a law ● veto - president refuses to sign a law ● appointments - nominate certain fed. gov't officials 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● judicial review - USSC decides constitutionality ● court order - doc. stating what someone can/cannot do in court ● writ of certiorari - doc. asking higher court to review lower case ● summary judgment - decision made by judge, no jury/trial
